Mission and Activities

The mission of the Japan Association for Women's Education (JAWE) is to contribute towards the promotion of lifelong learning and next generation development aimed at establishing a gender-equal society. The following activities are conducted in order to achieve these goals.



History

March 1941	The Nihon Joshi Kaikan, an incorporated foundation, was established
February 1945	Merged with the Association for Social Education, an incorporated foundation, and became the Dai-Nihon Women's Association for Social Education
March 1972	Renamed as the Japan Women's Association for Social Education, an incorporated foundation
April 2002	Renamed as the Japan Association for Women's Education, an Incorporated Foundation
April 2011	The association was changed into a public interest incorporated foundation.
March 2021	Cerebrated the 80th anniversary of the establishment.



Learning and Fostering



- Training and educating of “**JAWE Career Development Designers**” for the sake of empowering women to support their lifelong career design activities from a gender-equal perspective.
- Presenting of the “**Japan Association for Women’s Education Future Award**” for the most outstanding reports with the theme of new and fresh starts.

“Office We learn”



The Nihon Joshi Kaikan which is supervised and administered by our association had been built in Shiba-Koen in 1937 as the first camp-in training facility for women’s social education in Japan, attracting the hopes and expectations of women nationwide. Later, through the changes in time, the building was renovated in 1947, and now offers services contributing towards the development of a gender-equal society as well as providing office space for the public organization.

Nihon Joshi Kaikan is located in the Shiba-Koen district centering around the Zojoji temple, facing the park, so it is furnished with a peaceful environment rich in green foliage.

Monthly publication "We Learn"



A professional magazine for gender equality, highly recommended for those involved with the promotion of diversity, the promotion of active participation of women in society, and career development support.

Wide-ranging contents such as study reports concerning career support and so on, activity reports from within and out of Japan, information on films and new publications, and so on are actively adopted in business planning and enforcement for universities, NPOs, and women-related facilities nationwide.
